

Cannibal Attack

You and your friends are hiking through a remote jungle, when suddenly you are attacked and taken hostage by cannibals! Amazingly, one cannibal speaks perfect English! He tells you that one of you will be spared while the others will become spare ribs! Answer the cannibal's questions well to avoid being eaten!

QUESTIONS Ask students A,B & C these questions.	√ Check the best answer.

1. I want a new recipe. What is the best thing you can cook? BONUS: How often do you cook?			
2. We should exchange gifts before the meal. What would you give me? BONUS: When was the last time you gave someone a gift?			
3. We should sing while we cook. Which song can you sing well? BONUS: Have you ever serenaded someone (or been serenaded)?			
4. We should have a conversation during the meal. What should we talk about? BONUS: Are you a better talker or listener?			
5. We should eat dessert after the meal. What is your favorite dessert? BONUS: How often do you eat dessert?			
6. We should drink after the dessert. What would we drink? BONUS: How often do you drink alcohol?			
7. We should dance after drinking. What dance would you teach me? BONUS: When is the last time you went out dancing?			
8. We should play a game. What game would you teach me? BONUS: How often do you play games?			
9. It is a cannibal custom to get tattoos after such a special feast. What tattoo should we get? BONUS: Have you ever considered getting a tattoo?			
10. TIE-BREAKING QUESTION: Cannibals are adventurous eaters. What is the strangest food you've ever eaten? (or make up your own question.)			
TOTAL: The student with the most checks survives the cannibal attack!			

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Instructions:

- create groups: 3-5 students (In a group of 5, add a column for Student D)
- give the sheet to the 'cannibal'.
- The 'cannibal' asks the questions and chooses the best answers.
- The other students try to give amazing answers to please the cannibal.
- The one with the most check marks is the winner! (The others are cooked!)

10. Do you enjoy having a big feast with family or friends? Such as on Thanksgiving?
