## INSTRUCTIONS:

- Cut paper into 3 strips.
- Create groups of $3^{*}$.
- Set timer for 2:30.
- One students describes while the others guess the items.
- Repeat.


## - Set a timer for 2 minutes 30 seconds.

- When the timer starts, one student picks up a paper strip and describes what each item is used for while the other students guess.
- When the timer ends, count the correct answers and repeat with the next student and a new paper strip.
* In groups of 2, simply have the students repeat roles for the last paper strip.


## CUTTING VARIATIONS:

- This activity works best with 3 students per group and all students are racing to 'beat the clock'. However, you can easily divide the paper in other ways if you choose.


EXAMPLE: Demonstrate how to play using this example.


A: Children use this to color.
B: A crayon.
A: Right. This is used for buying something when you don't have cash. B: A check.
A: No. It is made of plastic.
$B$ : A credit card.
A: Correct!
