

WHO SAID IT?

- What's your favorite TV show?
- What house chore do you *not mind* doing?
- □ If you could be on the cover of any magazine, which magazine would you choose?

- What is the first thing you do when you get out of bed?
- What is something that you will probably buy soon?
- If you had 1 million dollars, what would you buy?

WHO SAID IT?

SET-UP:

- 1. Make groups consisting of 3-5 students (best with 4).
- 2. Hand out 1 question sheet per group and 1 answer sheet per student.

INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. One student chooses and asks a question. The others write down their answers on the answer sheet.
- 2. The student to the left of the 'questioner' collects all of the answer sheets and randomly reads the answers.
- 3. The 'questioner' must decide who wrote each answer and receives 1 point for each correct guess.
- 4. Repeat with the student on the left now choosing and asking a new question.
- 5. Continue for a set number of rounds or time limit.

note: The 'reader' should understand what is written on all the papers. Stumbling while reading is a big clue for the 'questioner'.

note: Encourage your students to have a short discussion after each round. It may be interesting to find out why certain answers were written.

- 3-5 students
- 1 question sheet / group
- 1 answer sheet / student
- 1 student asks a question.
- Others write their answers.
- Student on left of 'questioner' randomly reads all the answers.
- 'Questioner' guesses who said it.
- 1 point for each correct guess.
- Repeat with new 'questioner'.

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
